Deanery day for the deanery priests will be Tuesday, October 3<sup>rd</sup>. Fr. Kimminau will be providing supper for the priests, however asked for our help. We will provide a side salad and ice cream.

It was suggested to buy Hurts doughnuts for coffee and roll Sunday as a fund raiser. After some discussion, we decided to pass this idea on to the Fun Raising Committee.

It was decided to provide each Sister working in our Catholic with a \$25.00 scrip gift certificate in honor of the feast day of St. Teresa of the Child Jesus.

It was decided to give the Catholic radio station KVSS \$250.00
